BOOKING CONDITIONS

These booking conditions must be read in conjunction with any additional conditions outlined on the holiday selected.

IMPORTANT - Details of holidays and prices described in this brochure may have changed since the brochure was published.

RESERVATION AND DEPOSITS - Reservations may be accepted up to 30 days prior to departure, subject to availability of space. In Vogue does require a deposit at the time of booking. Naturally, if your reservation is unavailable for any reason, your deposit will be refunded to you in full. Balance of payment is due not later than 60 days prior to departure, or at the time of reservation for bookings received within 60 days prior to departure. Your travel documents will be forwarded, from our office, to your Travel Agent around 28 days before you are scheduled to depart Australia.

AIRLINE SERVICES - On rare occasions airline services may be delayed, for which In Vogue naturally, cannot be held responsible. In the event of a delayed flight affecting your holiday, you should be informed directly by the airline and advised of the revised arrangements the airline has made for you. Please ensure you advise In Vogue of a contact telephone number where you can be reached, immediately prior to your holiday departure from Australia. If your outbound flight is delayed in Vogue will, if so informed, make every effort to ensure that your hotel overseas is advised of your delay.

AMENDMENT TO BOOKING - Please note that an amendment fee will be charged where an amendment is requested, after confirmation of reservation. This fee is to cover the extra processing costs involved with making such arrangements. Any amendment 60 days, prior to departure, but prior to document issuance: \$35.00 per amendment per client. Any amendment once documents have been issued: \$50.00 per client, plus any cancellation fees imposed by any principal.

TOUR ALTERATIONS, CANCELLATIONS BY IN VOGUE - The travel arrangements outlined in this brochure were correct at the time of printing. However, events beyond our control may cause operational modification. Therefore In Vogue must reserve the right to modify or cancel scheduled tour departures at any time. Should the tour be cancelled by In Vogue an alternative departure will be offered or a full refund will be made of any monies which you may have paid.

CANCELLATIONS BY CLIENT - After you have made your reservation, In Vogue will make bookings for the holiday you have selected. If you cancel your reservation more than 60 days prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 50% of the deposit per person

will be levied to recoup the processing costs incurred. At 60 days prior to the departure of your holiday, In Vogue at its head office, 60 days or less prior to departure, a cancellation fee of the full deposit per person must be charged as compensation for services undertaken. No refund can be made if passengers, for any reason prematurely terminate their holiday. These cancellation fees will be in addition to any cancellation fee charged by any principal. For cancellation within 21 days of departure, the airlines may assess a cancellation penalty totalling 25% of the airfare used for that tour.

MEDICAL CERTIFICATES - Any disease or physical disability requiring particular attention or treatment, must be reported to In Vogue when booking. The right is reserved to refuse passage to anyone in such health or condition as to be, in the judgement of any Principal, unfit for travel.

AIR TRANSPORTATION - All air travel is based on economy class with any IATA, or non-IATA, carrier as nominated by In Vogue. Air tickets, in conjunction with all holidays, will be issued by In Vogue. Note: Routings of flights, shown in this brochure, are approximate only and are subject to rescheduling, at any time, by the airlines involved.

Any change made by clients to flights or air routing reserved for these holidays may incur severe financial penalties according to airline rules and regulations. For this reason you are strongly urged to take out an insurance policy to cover such penalties in the event of illness or other compassionate grounds.

AIRPORT DEPARTURE TAXES - When departing Australia (if you are 12 years or over), you will be required to pay a nominal departure tax - present charge is A\$20.00 and A\$5.00 custom clearance. This, and other airport taxes overseas are not included in the holiday prices quoted in this brochure.

INSURANCE PROTECTION - For your peace of mind we recommend you take out an insurance policy for loss of deposit, baggage personal accident and illness. You will be able to arrange special insurance coverage to give you adequate protection, should you be forced to cancel, for any of the reasons specified in the conditions.

ACCOMMODATION - Whilst every endeavour will be made to obtain the type of accommodation requested, please note that rooming is entirely at the discretion of each hotel. Twin Share accommodation is based on sharing twin or double bedded rooms as provided by the hotels. The arrangements for triple rooms vary from hotel to hotel. In some instances a triple room may comprise two double beds, or one double and one single bed requiring two persons to share the double bed. In other instances the room may

comprise two twin beds with a rollaway bed for the third person. We are unable to guarantee the exact composition of triple rooms in advance. However, the hotel will make every effort to allocate the most suitable arrangement. Single rooms accommodation, by choice or circumstance, must be reserved by persons travelling alone.

TOUR FARE DOES NOT INCLUDE - Charges for passports; visas where necessary; gratuities or meals (except where specified); items of a personal nature such as drinks and laundry; excess baggage charges;

vaccination and inoculation; any expenses in Australia; insurance protection and airport taxes.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS - We will be happy to assist you in obtaining the necessary passports and visas. For holidays in this brochure you will require a passport which should be valid for a minimum of six months after your return to Australia. Persons residing in Australia, who do not hold an Australian passport, will require a re-entry visa, obtainable from the Department of Immigration. Please check with In Vogue about current visa requirements and health regulations. Please note that passport and visa requirements are not the responsibility of In Vogue.

COMMUNICATION CHARGES - Where late reservations necessitate the use of cable, fax or telex, the cost incurred may be added to the tour fare.

UNUSED SERVICES - We regret that the holiday itineraries cannot be altered at the request of passengers. If you diverge from the arrangements, a refund cannot be made for any unused portion of the holiday. If passengers make any alteration to any portion of the holidays, such alteration will be completely at their own expense.

SPECIAL NOTE - The performance of all arrangements is subject to acts of God, war, government regulations, disaster, strikes, civil disorders, curtailment of transportation facilities or other emergencies. In Vogue cannot accept financial responsibility for the costs involved in providing alternative arrangements in such circumstances.

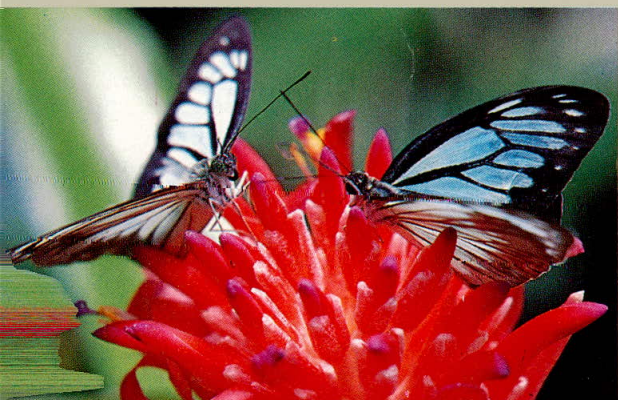
RESPONSIBILITY - In Vogue and/or its associated companies or agents give notice that they act as booking agents only for the persons or companies providing or offering the means of travel conveyance, transport, accommodation or other service and all receipts, tickets, vouchers, coupons or exchange orders are issued subject to the terms and conditions under which transportation and other services are provided.

So far as the company shall not be acting as such booking agent it shall be deemed to be acting as agent for the person making the booking. It is the responsibility of the passenger to ensure that she/he is in possession of the proper travel documents and that they are in compliance with the current government and transportation companies' regulations.

The right is reserved to modify the itinerary including the hotels mentioned in any way considered necessary or desirable or to change any reservation and/or means of conveyance without notice and for any reasons whatsoever and without allowance or refund by the extra cost, if any, resulting therefrom must be paid by the passenger. The right is also reserved to cancel or withdraw any tour.

The transportation companies or firms shall be exempt from all liability in respect of any detention, delay, loss, damage, sickness or injury, however and by whomsoever caused and of whatever kind occurring or to the passenger at any time when the passenger is not on board a carrier or conveyance used or operated by the transportation companies or firms.

Passage contracts in use by the transportation companies or firms concerned shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation companies or firms and the purchaser of these tours and/or passengers. These tour conditions contained the whole of the basis of contract between In Vogue and the passenger and exclude all other representations or warranties made by In Vogue, their agents or representatives.



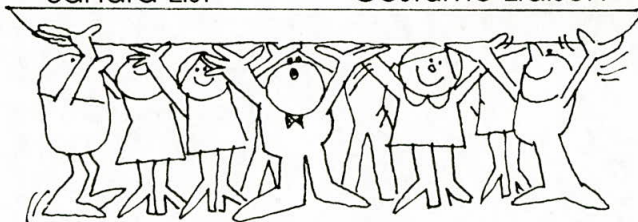
