35TH ANNUAL REPORT OF THE TREFOIL GUILD OF VICTORIA - OCTOBER 1988

The past twelve months have gone so quickly, and yet when I read through all your reports, the amount of service given to Guiding and the Community amazes me that so much has been accomplished in that period.

The number of Guilds' in the State has continued to increase with seven during the year, five since March this year, making the total sventy nine throughout Victoria. I have appreciated the invitations to visit so many of you in your own areas (to date 47), and it has been wonderful to see the way you support each other by attending neighbouring Guilds' Annual Meetings and fund raising functions. At one stage I was a little concerned that people were seeing the Trefoil Guild only in the role of ladies' who cater and serve suppers etc for special events, so now when I hear that you are being invited to Unit meetings to teach as well as assess for badges, I am sure this is good P.R. for the younger members' of the Movement as well as for us. As you read the reports of activities from individual Guilds', you will see why the image of the Trefoil Guild is making such an impression, and is recognized as an important section of the Guide Movement.

The Guilds' during the year have responded to requests from H.Q. to join their 'working bees' to pack calendars, prepare Introduction to Leadership Kits, staff the stand at The Royal Show, make teas for Trainings as well as support the Lady Murray Bowls Day, the Lady Delacome Golf Day and the Gowns through the Ages parade. As part of the G.G.Association of Victoria, we are involved with 'Greening Victoria' and the appeal

for the Royal Flying Doctor Service, which we are only too willing to support.

Many of our Trefoil Guilds' have had the opportunity to invite overseas Trefoil Guild members' to be their guests at meetings or other events during their stay in Victoria, also the correspondence link of 'Twinning' is another way to broaden our International understanding. In January of this year we entertained thirteen members' of the International Fellowship of Former Scouts and Guides (I.F.O.F.S.A.G.) from Belgium and they were very impressed that 'we would go to so much trouble for their little group'. Three of our members', Marjory Grigg, Irene Kerry and Betty Christie recently attended an Asia/Pacific Gathering in Indonesia, also Irene (Kerry) has just returned from her annual International Fellowship Meeting which was held in Brussels.

You have again been most generous with your donations to

various funds within Guiding and also to your Community groups.

We had a very busy annual Trefoil Guild weekend at Britannia Park in October last year. The weather was perfect and we had a capacity crowd in residence, giving an indication that we might have to look for alternative accommodation if it is the wish of the members' that we continue to have a residential weekend which incorporates the Annual Meeting. The Annual Meeting was held on the Saturday and on the Sunday we had the 'changeover' ceremony of the National Joint Council to Victoria to be administered in this State until October 1990. Thinking Day/Founder's Day was celebrated at Hepburn Springs with members of the Trefoil Guild and B-P Scout Guild enjoying a weekend of friendship and fellowship.

You might be interested to know some of the other meetings I I attend regularly, Advisers', State Council, B-P Guild executive, the Robert and Olave Baden-Powell Trust Fund and one that has just comeoff the list is the National Gathering Committee.

What was probably Victoria's challenge for the Bi-centenary year was the 8th National Gathering of Trefoil Guilds' held at Monash Uni-versity 19th to 21st August. With a very competent committee under the leadership of Shirley Reeves, we planned, organized and counted for thirteen months - the theme was "Let's make friends' " and I am sure this was achieved by all who attended - 214 in residence with every State represented and day visitors swelling our numbers to 260. Thankyou to the Guilds' who gave donations and to those who made the delightful craft gifts and supplied the other 'goodies' for the bags.
