

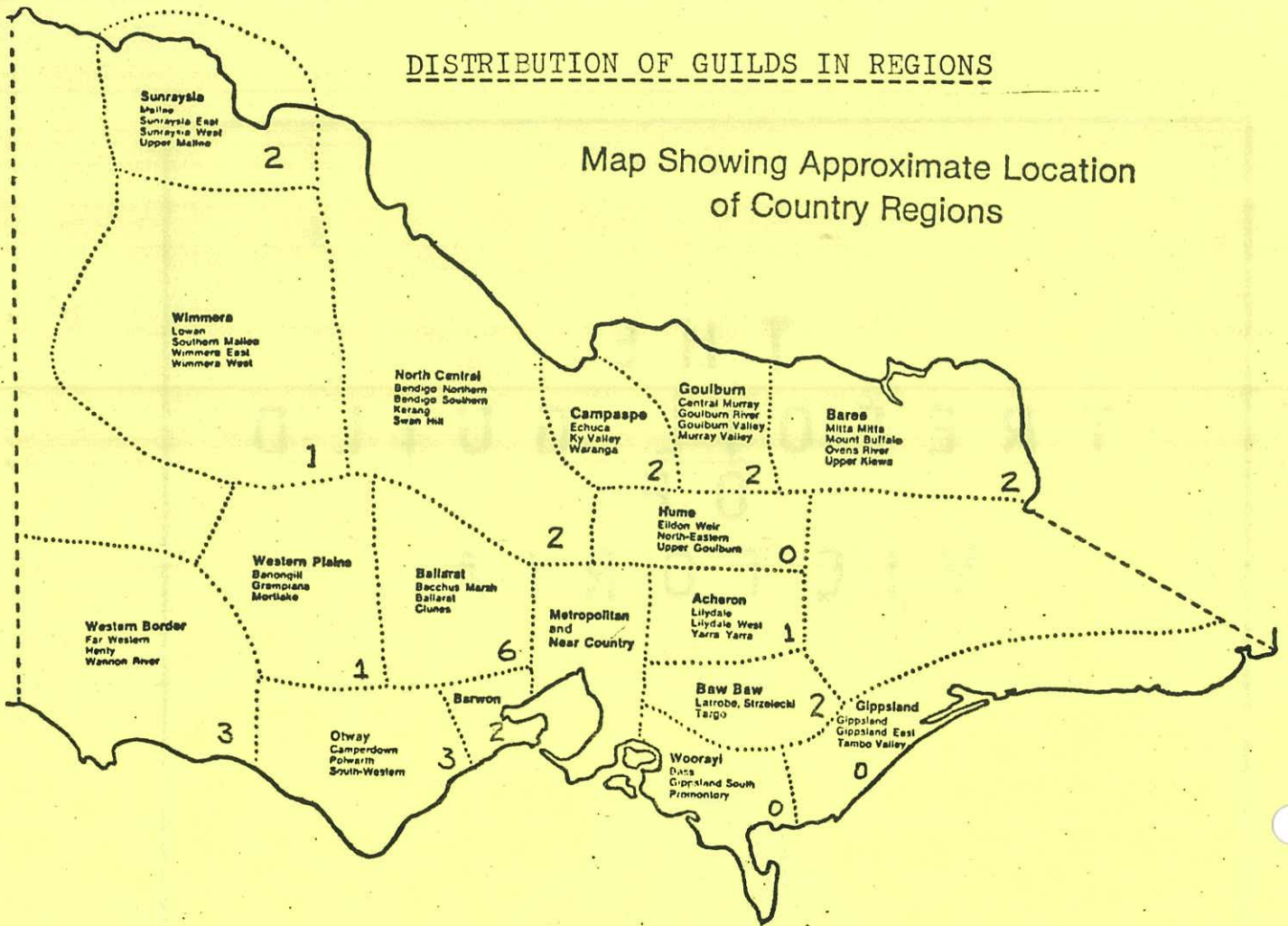

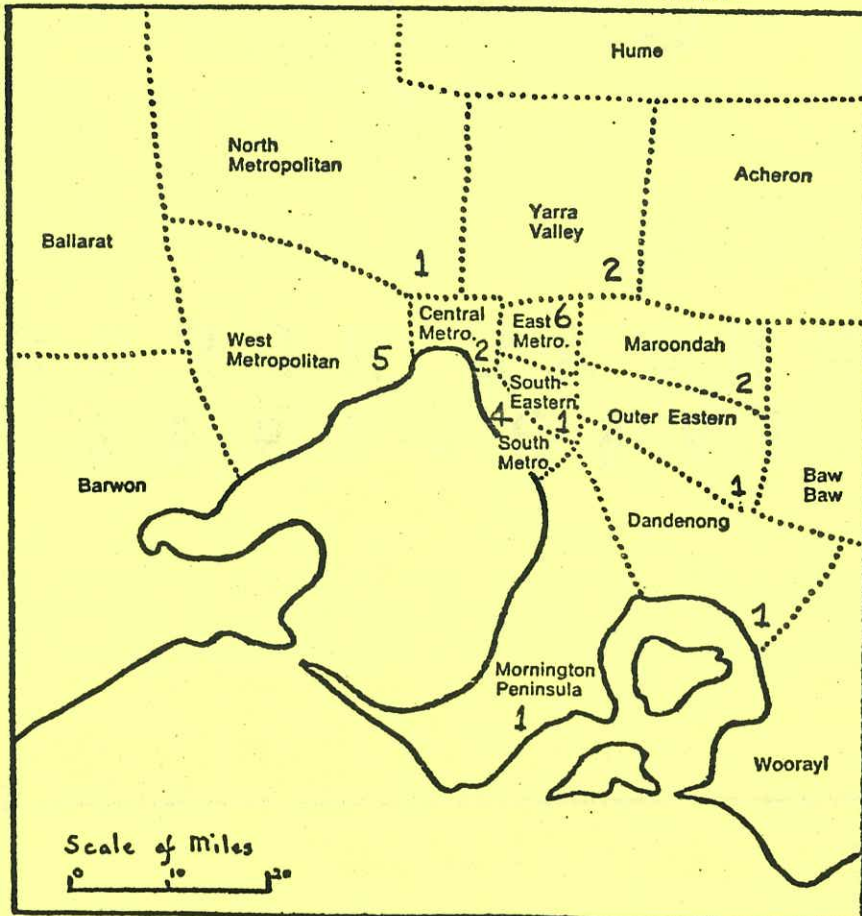

It is pleasing to report that the Trefoil Guild has continued to grow during the past twelve months. The two Guilds on the Mornington Peninsula have combined to become 'The Dolphin', meeting at Red Hill. After 34 years of activity, during which it gave very much valuable service, Eastern Suburbs Guild has now found it impossible to continue to function, but several of the remaining members have been able to join existing Guilds. Sadly, other Guilds have also lost members through death and illness, and sympathy is extended to them all. But new members have joined, and with the establishment of 'Juminama' at Beaumaris, The Trainers' Guild at State level, and the re formation, after several years, of a Guild in Outer Eastern Region, there are now approximately 1,030 members in 59 Guilds.

Variety in the type of activities, and the amount of assistance both practical and financial which Guilds have given to the community as well as to Guiding, seem endless. The presentation of Community, Guiding, and long service awards to a growing number of our members, shows that their contribution is being recognised. Some idea of the measure of involvement can be gained from the accompanying report of individual Guilds' activities.

Forty three residents and eleven day visitors took part in the State Gathering Weekend at Britannia Park in October '83, and for the second year in succession, very heavy rain fell during the weekend.

The very successful Trainers' Travelling Fund Luncheon held at Guide Headquarters in November, although planned and catered for by a Committee of Trefoil Guild members, was an exercise in total co-operation between all sections of the Movement.

Several functions in which all Guilds were invited to take part, were organised by individual Guilds, and proved to be very successful and enjoyable - 'Akoona's' Wildflower Day at Mt. Beckworth, (September '83); Merle Bush's Carol Service at Williamstown, (December '83); Town and Country's Bus Trip to Werribee Park and Swan Hill's Twenty Four Hour Gathering at the Pioneer Settlement (both March '84).

Members of both the Baden-Powell Scout Guild and the Trefoil Guild attended the combined Founder's Day/Thinking Day Weekend at the New Chalet Guest House, Hepburn Springs in February, and close co-operation between the two Guilds has continued.

During the year it has been my privilege and pleasure to attend functions or meetings of 29 Guilds, which has enabled me to meet so many more of our members. As well as attending Advisers' and State Council Meetings, I have been able to be present at the Commissioners' Conference, two Region Conferences, two Commissioner Training Sessions, lunch time at the Region Commissioners' Meetings, and many other Guiding functions, all of which have presented opportunities to promote the Trefoil Guild.

In September we took an active part in the 'All Adult Seminar', at Wilson Hall, with three members in the Colour Party, and our own Section Time.

Individual members have attended International events during the year. Council Member, Miss Amy Bush, was present at the IFOFSAG International Council Meeting in Brussels in March, Miss Irene Kerry and Mrs Betty Christie took part in the Asia Pacific Region Gathering of IFOFSAG in Sri Lanka in August, and in September Mrs Marie Stubbs and Mrs Verna Surry attended the Asia Pacific Region Gathering for Adults and Friends, in Perth.

Seventeen Victorians travelled to Perth in August for the happy and successful 6th National Gathering of Trefoil Guilds, and several of them joined with South Australia for a tour which followed the Gathering.

So many people are involved in the manner in which the Trefoil Guild functions, and my sincere thanks go to them all - to Australian Trefoil Guild Adviser, Mrs Adelaide Edwards, and her Assistant, our own Mrs Marie Stubbs, for their advice and friendship; to State Commissioner, Mrs Maren Chandler, for her encouragement; to State Secretary, Miss Jill Johnstone who always manages to have the answer to any query; to Miss Margaret Shaw as Editor, and her Committee, for the production of 'Australian Fellowship News' which keeps us informed of State, National, and International events; to Guild Officebearers (especially Secretaries), and members, for their friendship, co-operation and ready response to the many requests made; to Treasurer, Miss Irene Kerry, for the excellent management of our financial affairs; to Mr Bob Parsons who has Audited our books for this and the two previous Annual Meetings; to my husband Eughie for his assistance, especially with all the necessary printing; and to the members of my own Guild, 'Argana', and in particular, Mrs Beryl Weaver, for their wonderful support in every possible way.

In recent weeks there have been enquiries about the probable formation of another two Guilds, so further growth seems certain. Could we, as a way of celebrating the 75th Year Of Guiding, each try during the next twelve months, to bring in one new member, to make that growth so much greater?.
