37TH ANNUAL REPORT - VICTORIAN TREFOIL GUILD - 1989 / 1990

This is the 37th annual report of the Victorian Trefoil Guild, and it is my privilege and pleasure to present it to you.

It is with anticipation and interest that I await the arrival of the annual reports from each guild, for this is where the information of activities and membership numbers are taken from.

At the 1st May 1990, there were eightysix guilds with fourteen hundred and thirteen fimancial members, of this number, one hundred and forty six were associate members. It is always a pleasure to be part of guild meetings and social events, and during the past twelve months, I received a very warm welcome on accepting fifty nine invitations to all corners of the State.

I was able to join in three Region conferences giving me the opportunity to meet with country members. There have been meetings with members of the Baden-Powell Scout Guild, State Council, Advisers' and Region Commissioners', National Joint Council, Robert & Olave Baden-Powell Trust Fund, Sailing Centre, Girl Guides Association of Victoria and Lones L.A. annual meetings. Other events attended have been the Opening of the Sailing Season and Blessing of the Fleet, Women in Management seminar, reception for members' of the Olave Baden-Powell Society, new Leaders day, Commissioners' conference, training department dinner, cocktail party, headquarter's 21st Birthday celebrations, Melbourne Gang Show, Thinking Day/Founders Day weekend, Lady Murray bowls day, Gumnut Guide launch and the Lady Stradbroke Cup at Dandenong campsite.

1989 was the year for a residential State trefoil guild weekend. Because of limited sleeping accommodation at Britannia Park, we had to look for another venue. Lady Northcote recreation camp at Bacchus Marsh was chosen and we had a record attendance, especially on the Saturday when we welcomed day visitors increasing our numbers to one hundred and fifty for the annual meeting.

When typing information from the guild annual report forms to write the Victorian report for our Australian Trefoil Guild Adviser, it made me feel so proud of you all when I read all you had done to support guiding and your local communities, this service was given in time, talents and financial support.

I do not have a total record of all donations given as many guilds send or give personally during the year to the appeals or organizations that interest them. Just from the figures taken from the annual report forms, funds within guiding benefitted by \$2,001.83 and other donations given amounted to \$2,330.00, these amounts do not include the 'mahjong fiesta' or more recently the Tuvalu or Tonga Mutual Aid projects. Thankyou for your generosity.

We seem to thrive on challenges so it did not take much persuading to undertake the translation of 'Alice in Wonderland' into Morse code for the Carroll Foundation. With members and their husbands, leaders and guides, it was all completed in three months.

Members have been honoured by their local communities by being named 'Citizen of the Year', and many have received Long Service Awards. Congratulations to them all, also to guilds who have celebrated 10, 30, 40 & 50 years of friendship, fellowship and service.

I am sure everyone will be interested in reading what each individual guild's activities have been during the year, the scope for service just seems endless and I know that by including all the details it will continue to inspire members to keep looking wider.

Victorian members who attended the 18th General Assembly in Aalborg in August 1989 have been invited to share this experience with other guilds, another International event that members participated in was the tour of World Centres.

In October 1987, Victoria became the administering State for the Aust raliam Fellowship of Former Scouts and Guides - National Joint Council. This Council consists of three trefoil guild members - Mrs Marjory Grigg, Australian Trefoil Guild Adviser who is vice chairman, Mrs Isobel Lister who was appointed by Victoriam Executive is International secretary and I am the treasurer, the other three positions of chairman, secretary and 'Bulletim' secretary are held by Baden-Powell guild members. With the three year term finishing im October, Victoria will pass this role over to New South Wales on the 21st October with a changeover ceremony in that State. Mrs Grigg, as Australian Trefoil Guild Adviser will become chair man until the end of her term.

Our members at present are preparing to attend the 9th National Gathering of Trefoil Guilds to be held in Brisbane, 21st to 23rd September. It is two years since we hosted this event, so those going are looking forward to renewing and making new friends.

25th August 1990 is a special day for Victorian Trefoil Guilds as it sees the first publication of our history. It was Mrs Marjory Grigg's dream to have this writtem, so when Mrs Doris Spratling accepted this challenge, she undertook a mammoth task gathering all the information, today we are going to see the culmination of all that work. Thankyou Doris from all of us.

Whether being a support to each other, raising funds for special projects, enjoying their own guild meetings or with other guilds, or giving service, the trefoil guild gives the opportunity to all it's members to renew or continue that special friendship that is found in the Guide Movement.

As I comclude this report, I thank you all for your continuing support and friendship. I appreciate the privilege of having the Australiam Adviser and her assistant Mrs Beryl Weaver living in Victoria and for their availability when I need advice or information. My thanks also to Miss Ireme Kerry for her efficiency as State treasurer. To our State Commissioner Mrs Dorothy Woolley, her three assistants, Mrs Ann McNamara, Mrs Anne Scott and Mrs Glenda Culley, State Secretary Miss Jill Johnstone, all the Advisers and headquarters staff, thankyou for your interest in the trefoil guild and it's activities, we appreciate the opportunities givem to our members to participate in special events with the Girl Guides Association of Victoria.


